Hello,

At this time, we are waiting on State guidelines and procedures on what we can do at the Community Center/Fitness area, for now the Community Center/Fitness area will remain closed.

The Swimming Pool, we are waiting on State guidelines and procedures if we can open the Community Pool. The Swimming Pool, will remain closed until the District gets updated regulations/guidelines from the State. We have seen the CDC's new recommendations on pools, but again waiting on actual requirements from the State of Colorado.

Governor Polis had signed a document back on 5/14/2020 putting "pools" in with playground and other like items, so we are waiting until 5/26/2020 to see if anything changes on the new phase plan that will be put out on polices and or procedures.

The District is still cleaning and getting the pool ready for opening if we are allowed to open the pool. Even if we were told we could not open, we still would have had to clean the pool and the piping of the pool. We could not let algae, molds and fungus grow in the pool for two years.

The Districts has a few ideas that are being discussed with the board on how to open the pool, but again waiting on actual requirements.

More than likely we will have to <u>limit the number of District residents</u> into the pool area and there will be NO<u>GUESTS</u> allowed and/or POOL PARTIES will be allowed. Please don't ask if your relatives, close family members or friends can come in to swim and/or hang out. The pool area will be limited on how many people can gather and we want the residents to be able to use the pool if allowed to open.

If needed we will be setting up a reservation system and having time slots for limited times to reserve during hours of operations for a limited number of people. If reservations are what is needed, a link will be sent out to sign up for reservations and rules. No walk ups will be allowed, this may change at a later date. More than likely; little too no pool furniture will be in the pool area. Again, **only District residents will be allowed access to the pool when it opens**.

The Pool hours of operation if allowed to open will be posted on the web site and at the Community Pool when we learn what the required social distancing, physical distancing requirements, restrictions, along with size of groups that can gather.

Once we have a general idea the pool can open, the District will need time to get all policies and procedures ready before opening.
