At this time, the Districts are still waiting on the State and/or County to give permission to open the District facilities to the public. The District needs the proper policies and procedures on COVID-19 from the State and County in order to open the facilities for the safety of the public.

The Districts and/or the Boards want to open the Community Center & Pool along with the Parks as much as you do, but we are following all State of Colorado Executive Orders and Guidance.

As you may know, for the most part you can go to The State and/or County web sites to verify any information. The Districts and the Board of Directors do not review News stories, Social Media, or any articles to make decisions on what and when it is safe to open any amenities, we are waiting for the State and/or County to give direction to the Districts.

As for any cost associated to the amenities the Districts and in turn the homeowners still have all the operations & maintenance along with any repairs that are still being performed. The only different is some amenities are not allowed to be open at this time due to COVID-19.

The only item budgeted and not being charged to District at this time is lifeguard coverage. The life guards are still training and getting ready in hopes to return to work if allowed to open. When allowed to open, the Districts will have added cost due to COVID-19 with new polices, regulations, and a strict cleaning regiment for the safety of the public.

Please, if you have any questions feel free to call the Districts. We want to open the Community Center, Pool and Parks as much as you do. As I am sure you have seen, the pool is roughly 90% ready for operations, we as the District and Board are anxiously waiting for State requirements to complete opening procedures.
